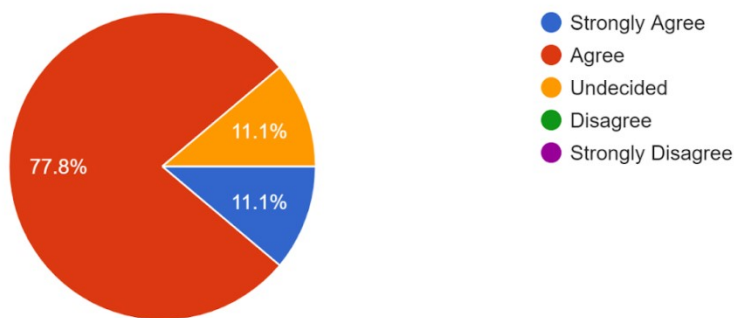

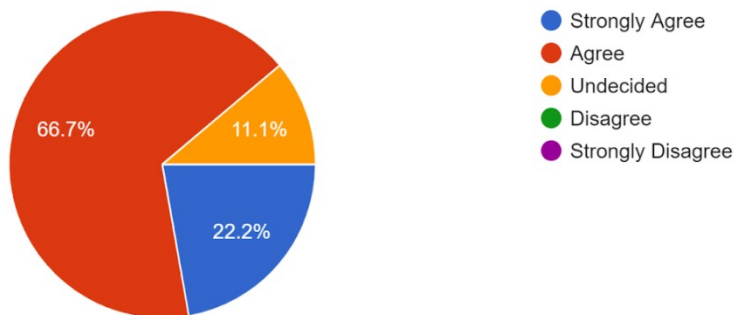
1. The syllabus for LL.B students is sufficed for their life-long learning

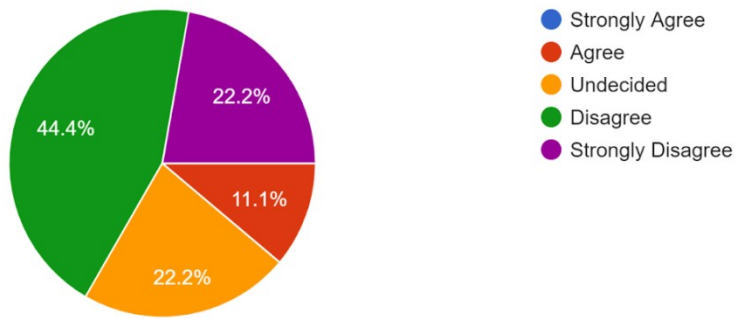

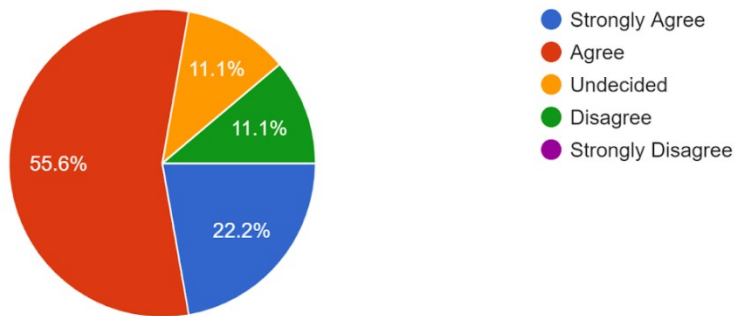

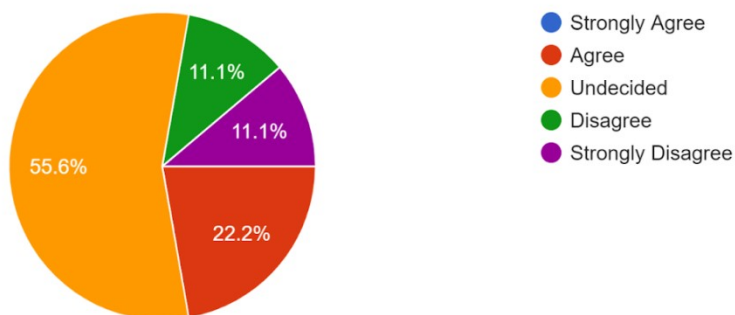

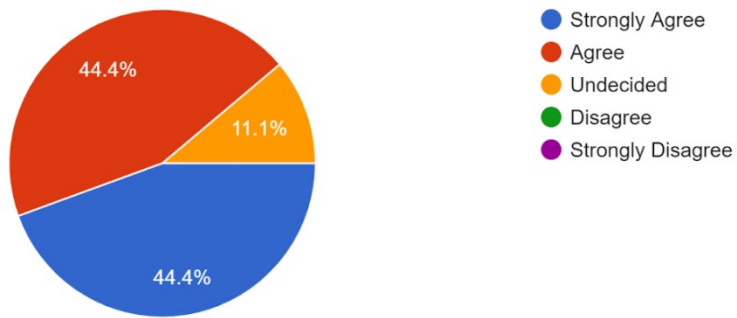

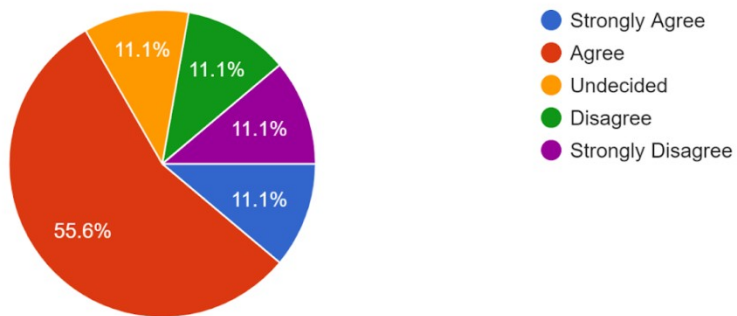

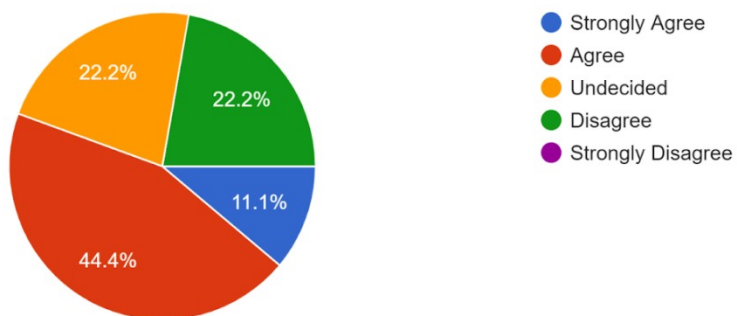

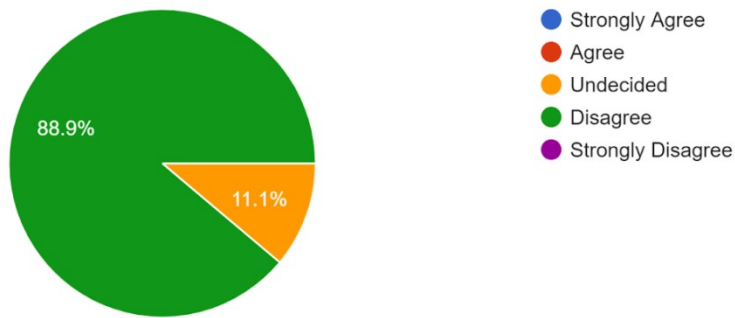
