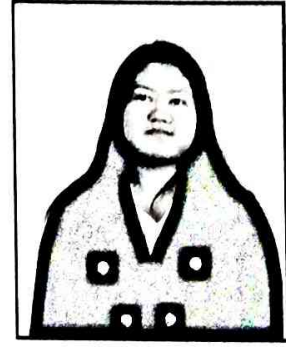


## REPORTS FROM GENERAL SECRETARY
